### Player Overview

Carl Stockwell (born April 15, 1998) is a physically imposing Swedish center-forward who defines the "Target Man" archetype. Standing at an exceptional 204cm, his profile is built around extreme aerial dominance and the ability to act as a primary focal point for direct attacking transitions.

### Physical Profile


Stockwell possesses a massive, tall frame that he uses effectively to dominate duels. His strength and balance allow him to shield the ball under pressure and sustain a high volume of physical contests throughout 90 minutes. Despite his size, he shows surprising mobility, capable of powerful full-speed running to attack space during transitions.

### Technical & Tactical Analysis

His game is centered on efficiency rather than intricate flair. Technically, he excels in hold-up and link-up play, utilizing controlled lay-offs and flick-ons to progress teammates. He is a reliable outlet for long distributions, consistently winning first contacts and showing high awareness of second-ball dynamics. While his first touch under intense pressure is functional rather than standout, his finishing profile is varied, utilizing both his head and feet effectively.


Tactically, he is most effective in 4-3-3 or 4-2-3-1 systems that emphasize direct play and wide crosses. He maintains a disciplined central presence, often positioning himself at the back post or making box-oriented movements. Out of possession, he maintains team structure as a lone striker but is not an aggressive presser.
